Entry fee is \$20 for members and \$25 for non-members. If you would like to become a member or to renew your membership please check the entry form.

Entries must be postmarked by January 18, 2014. No late entries accepted.

Artists 18 years of age and older may enter up to 4 recent original artworks not previously shown at the Vasaloppet Art Show. Vasaloppet themed art is encouraged.

All works of art must be the original works, conceived and executed solely by the artist.

Wall art must be properly framed and wired for hanging. Label back with name, phone, title & price.

Work may be priced for sale. KCAA handles all sales and if sold, 15% of sales price goes to KCAA.

In addition to your art show entries, it is encouraged to donate a piece of your artwork to the silent auction. The silent auction is a fundraiser for KCAA's Scholarship Fund. 100% of the winning sale bid will go into the fund.
