### CSA Membership

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) members consciously share the risk and benefits with the farmer. Members purchase their share before the growing season, in the winter or early spring. Sapsucker Farms purchases the seeds, plants, nurtures the crops throughout the growing season, harvests, cleans, and packs the produce for members to pick up at their desired location. Members also have the opportunity to visit the farm and share in tasks if they so desire.

### CSA Member Share options

**Weekly (Full) share \$450** – ½ bushel box per week, 18 to 20 weeks from June through October  
Box size is 14 ½" wide X 11" deep X 7 ½" tall.

**Bi-weekly (Half) share \$250** – Same ½ bushel box as weekly/full share, but pick up is every-other-week, 9 to 10 weeks from June through October.

## Sign up for Sapsucker Farms 2014 Vegetable & Fruit Summer CSA

Our CSA season runs 18 to 20 weeks from June thru October, excluding one week (date TBD) for farmer's week off. We will notify you when the first week of produce will be ready to be picked up.

A limited number of shares are available, sold on a first-come-first-served basis. **\$25 (non-refundable) down payment reserves your 2014 share and all shares must be paid in full by May 1, 2014.** Payment plans can be accommodated. For your convenience, the \$25 deposit to reserve your share may be placed via our online store on our website [www.sapsuckerfarms.com](http://www.sapsuckerfarms.com) as well.

During the growing season, boxes can be picked up at Sapsucker Farms, City Center Market in Cambridge, Good Earth Co-op in St. Cloud, or delivered to select offices in St. Cloud (by special arrangement).

By signing up for this CSA share, you acknowledge that you also share the risk of farming with the farmer. While many crops are planned to be planted, some crop failure, storm damage, or critter predation may occur, resulting in that crop not being available in your CSA box.
