Traffic crashes are the leading cause of death to young people. Inadequate skills, limited driving experience, and poor decision making, are contributing factors to serious crashes for teen drivers. The majority of these crashes are preventable. The (MHSRC) is taking steps to make a positive impact on young drivers through our Crash Avoidance/Parent Awareness Class.



In this fast paced, hands on, teens will drive our vehicles on challenging maneuvers, on a closed course, under the supervision of professional instructors. This four hour class will target many of the casual factors cited in teen crashes; hazard recognition and avoidance, reaction time limitations, off road recovery, and skid recovery to name a few. This is not drivers ed! At least one parent is required to attend a two hour safety presentation that we call, "The Real Risk of the Young Driver". Parents will then have the opportunity to observe their teen in action.

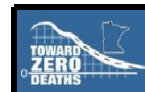
