


Old Tyme Country School 2015

When:

- Session I: Monday, July 20 through Friday, July 24, 2015
- Session II: Monday, July 27 through Friday, July 31, 2015
- Session III: Monday, Aug. 3 through Friday, Aug. 7, 2015
- Three sessions, each 5 consecutive days from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Who:

Priority for students having completed grades 1 through 8 who reside in Kanabec County and/or attend the Kanabec County School systems, but anyone is encouraged to apply.

Cost:

- \$42.50 per student for members of Kanabec County Historical Society
- \$62.50 per student for non-members

Details:

- Students will arrive at school each day in costume ready to participate in a 1920's school day.
- Cold lunch must be brought from home appropriate for the era.
- Parents are responsible for transportation to and from school.
- Each session is limited to 25 students.
- Students are not allowed to bring other students as guests during the day.
- Parents are to notify Center if student will be absent or if someone other than parent/guardian will pick student up at end of the day.

The families and friends of participating students are cordially invited on Friday of each week at 1:00 PM to attend an ice cream social, and students are encouraged to bring a treat to share from home (cookies, bars, etc.). The History Center will provide a beverage and ice cream.

Registration:

Registration form(s) must be completed and returned or mailed to the Kanabec History Center (address above) as soon as possible, enclosing appropriate fee. Forms are available on our website, kanabechistory.org, in a printable form, or in our office.

Acceptance:

All students are enrolled as registered and ensured their spot with payment of fee. You will be notified if session is full.
